We light the candle of joy to remind us that through Jesus there will be everlasting joy on earth. The presence of Jesus with us is like a


spark of joy that we carry even through the deepest darkness. Joy is like a light shining in a dark place.



Kviteseid Lutheran Church Joint Council Minutes

December 18, 2024

Members Present: Tom Moe, Rob Schwendemann, Sherry Norby, Andy Streed, Brandon Ascheman, Cory Heinrich, Ray Trager, Jon Hanson, Heidi Spray, Cheryl Erp, Andrea Westra and Pastor Kristine Isder.

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by President Tom Moe.

Pastor Kristine gave devotions and a prayer.

Secretary's Report: The secretary's report was reviewed with no changes.

Treasurer's Report: Andy Streed reported the Building Fund received an anonymous donation of \$25.000. The church budget will be in the black at the end of the year.

Deacon's Report: Heidi Spray reported that out of the nine Welcome baskets delivered, the church received three new members. Attendance varies with 147 attending the December 15th service and Christmas program. The teachers and students did a very nice program. The Jingle Offering for kids has over \$80. There are several Micronesian students attending our Sunday School. There were over 300 people served communion at the Welling wedding.

Trustee's Report: Cory Heinrich reported they had narrowed down

the color of the landscape brick to three colors and one will be selected. Tosel Construction will do the work next spring/summer. Southwest Glass of Marshall has been contacted to repair the caulk, etc. on some of the windows. Theresa Erickson, church secretary/ bookkeeper, is resigning effective April 30, 2025. This position will be open for applications.

Board of Education: Nothing to report.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Kristine reported that worship attendance has been ranging from 46 - 147. Online worship is 100-200 per Sunday. She heard very good comments about the Sunday School program. Several Micronesian students are attending Sunday School and Confirmation. The Endowment The next scheduled council meeting Board met and gave out \$24,000 in donations. The Endowment Board is looking for three new members. Area churches are reporting they are experiencing the need for pastoral care and leadership. Pastor Kristine reported she will be retiring effective June 30, 2025, and handed out information on the Call Process.

Motion was made by Rob Schwendemann, seconded by Jon Hanson, to approve the reports. Motion carried.

Old Business: The agreement with Big Bend Church for pastoral services was updated. In lieu of a church supper, members are asked to contribute money.

New Business:

- Big Bend will have Fat Tuesday/Ash Wednesday service

March 4 and Lenten services on March 12 and March 26. Kviteseid will also hold an Ash Wednesday service and have the remaining Lenten services.

- The Annual Meeting will be held Sunday, January 19, at the conclusion of the service. Reports for the annual meeting are due January 3.
- The Nominating Committee consists of Char Strand, Josh Moen, Jessica Trager, Brian Olson, Jenna Norby and Lorrie Spray.
- Pastor discussed the Call Process and reported that the church's Constitution needs to be updated.

We closed the meeting by praying the Lord's Prayer.

Last year *Living Lutheran* (formerly The Lutheran Magazine), ceased as a print publication and continued as a digital-only service because of financial constraints. Since then, Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton and staff heard concerns about members who don't have access to computers or don't read online content for various reasons. As a result, people have felt disconnected from the ELCA.

At the request of Bishop Eaton, the ELCA has found a way to bring back the magazine's print magazine. Each issue will feature updates on the church and the ELCA and also stories.

Beginning in 2025, *Living Lutheran* will publish four issues a year (spring, summer, winter and fall). The cost for one year will be \$19.95 for an individual subscription and \$17.00 per year for a congregation group subscription.
